



How can our Integrated Family Support Service help?

Using evidence-based programs and practices, Integrated Family Support Service works to improve the safety, wellbeing and health of children and their families – from before birth to 18 years.

This service offers practical parenting assistance and strategies, casework and case management services for families experiencing challenges and vulnerabilities.

We provide practices to improving confidence and enjoyment in parenting as well as managing challenging childhood behaviours.

We work in partnership with the Strong Families Safe Kids Advice and Referral Line and we will consult with them if there are serious concerns about children's safety or welfare.

Families with young children

We provide programs to create a safe and nurturing environment for children, with strategies and practical skills around parenting.

Families with teenagers

- We provide help with understanding the developmental stages of children and adolescents.
- Practices dealing with the impact of substance abuse and dealing with the impact of mental health issues.
- Support managing family conflict and breakdown and accessing social and professional support networks within the community.
- Practicing time management and providing other parenting resources.

What should you expect from our Integrated Family Support Service?

We work in the best interests of children to ensure their safety and development and with parents to address the needs of their children.

There is active engagement with families through assertive outreach, providing coordination and case management services and linking in with existing community networks.
