What is JumpStart?

JumpStart is our rental support program in Tasmania for 18–24-year olds who are ready for independent living and have started vocational education and training.

JumpStart is a supported program where participants live in a private rental and get tailored employment and property management support depending on their needs.

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Eligibility

To be eligible for our JumpStart pilot program, you must be:

- A young person aged between 18 and 24 years of age; and
- Be ready to live independently.
- Be earning a regular income.

Commitment

You must remain committed to our program while we are supporting you.

You'll need to meet with us and participate in support designed to help you live on your own. We may also ask you to help us promote the program with stories and pictures across media platforms.

Process

If you're interested in applying, here's what to do next:



Complete our online application form.



Meet with our program coordinator to determine readiness and discuss support options.



If house sharing, view property and meet other participants.



If accepted, sign contract and move into share house.



Participate in regular reviews and inspections.
