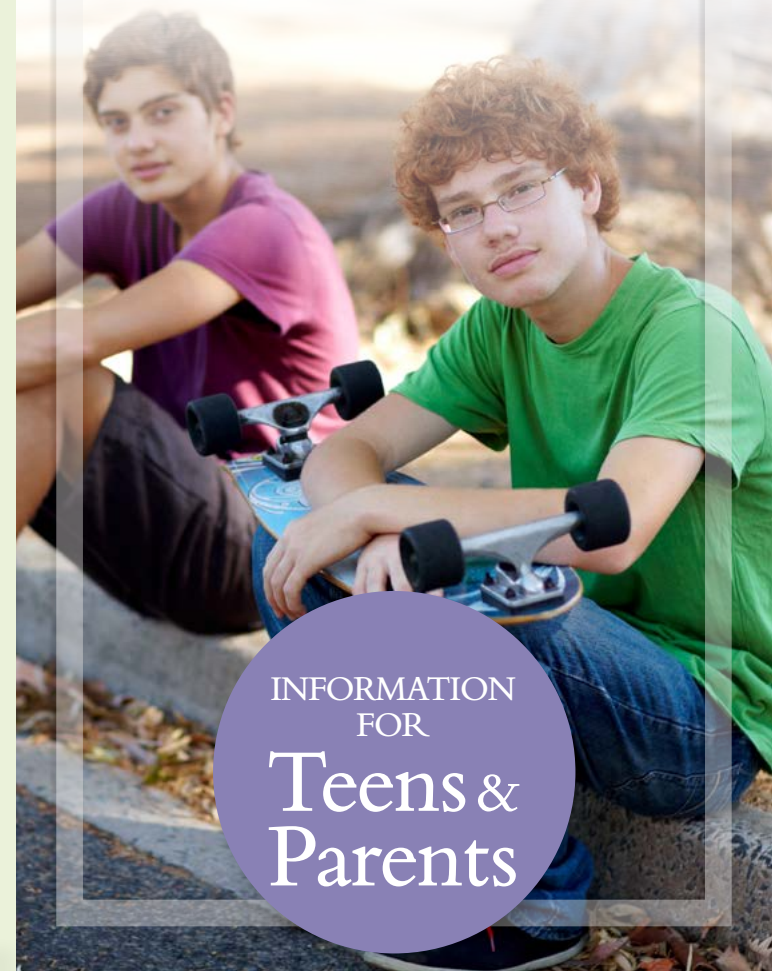

## How can our Targeted Youth Support Service help?

Baptcare's Targeted Youth Support Service youth program works with young people aged 10 to 18-years old who are identified as having significant and/or multiple risk issues including homelessness or the risk of becoming homeless.

This program is suitable for participants who are at risk of referral to, or escalation within Child Safety or Youth Justice systems.

Targeted Youth Support Service is a partnership between Baptcare, Department for Education, Children and Young People.

We will consult with the Strong Families Safe Kids Advice and Referral Line if there are serious concerns about children's safety or welfare.

## What we offer participants

### We are collaborative

Listening to you, we identify a common purpose.  
Working with you, we support you to reach your goals.

### We are child-centred and family focused

We value your individual interests and goals. We respect your right to participate in and guide planning, decisions and actions affecting your life.

### We are optimistic and genuine

Staff are honest and open with you, and will assist you to ensure the best available outcomes.

### We celebrate diversity

Everyone is different – and we celebrate our differences.  
We include all people to ensure safety and wellbeing.

## Therapeutic intervention

The service aims to re-engage young people in education, training, employment and housing. We provide intensive support and casework services for at risk young people.

### Evidence-based best practice

Using evidence-based programs and practices, our supports, therapies and practices are tailored to you, based on your needs.
